

Bangs Lake User:

Construction has begun at the Bangs Lake Marina property located at 231 E Liberty St in Wauconda. We are excited for the new opportunities this project will provide our patrons once it is complete! During this time, we appreciate your patience and understanding as we navigate construction. We understand that the traditional boating season will be impacted by the construction schedule, and we are working with our construction team to minimize the impact this has on your summer.

Beach Park Marina (121 Murphy St) dates:

- April 1 = Keys change for the 2026 season and parking passes are available at the Community Center. These can be picked up during office hours which are: Monday-Friday from 8:30 am-5:00 pm and open until 6:00 pm on Fridays.
- May 1 = Beach Park Marina piers will be available for slip customers. If we can get the piers in earlier than May 1, you will be notified.

TENTATIVE Bangs Lake Marina (231 E Liberty St) dates:

Construction can go faster than expected or take longer than expected for reasons out of our control. We are hoping to stay on track with the dates below; however, we can not guarantee access on the dates provided:

- **TENTATIVE** May 15 = Bangs Lake Marina Piers will be available for slip customers, with launching available at Beach Park Marina or alternate location(s).
- **TENTATIVE** June 10 = Bangs Lake Marina launch will be available for users. Bait Shop will be open for bait, fuel, and rental sales.

Until the launch ramp is ready for use at the Bangs Lake Marina, all marina users will have access to the Beach Park Marina launch. We are working with other launch locations on Bangs Lake and local boat companies to provide additional access. We will share options once they are confirmed.
