1. Call to Order – Commissioner Starkey called the committee meeting to order at 6:06 pm.
2. Roll Call – Commissioner Starkey, Commissioner Berrelez, Commissioner Carr, Commissioner Tallman, Commissioner Bianco, Executive Director Staton, Director Babicz, Resident David Jakubek, and Resident Monica Glavey were all present for the meeting. JoAnn Freeman attended as a spectator.
3. Introduction of Committee Members – Executive Director Staton took a few moments to introduce the committee members.
4. Approval of the Agenda – A motion to approve the agenda was made by Commissioner Berrelez and seconded by Commissioner Tallman. Voice Vote: all aye, none opposed.
5. Overview of the Decennial Committee on Government Efficiency - Executive Director Staton provided the committee with an overview of the committee. The goal is to provide a report to the county no later than December 10, 2024. Staton answered all questions asked by the committee.
