Animal 1. I jump without wings, swim without fins, and sing without a mouth. What am I?

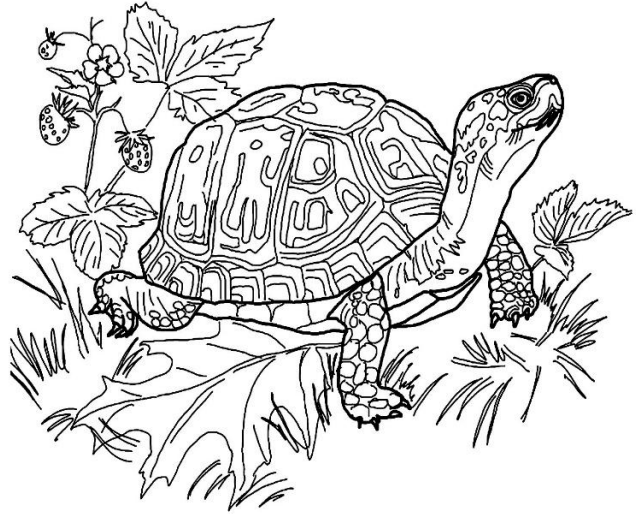

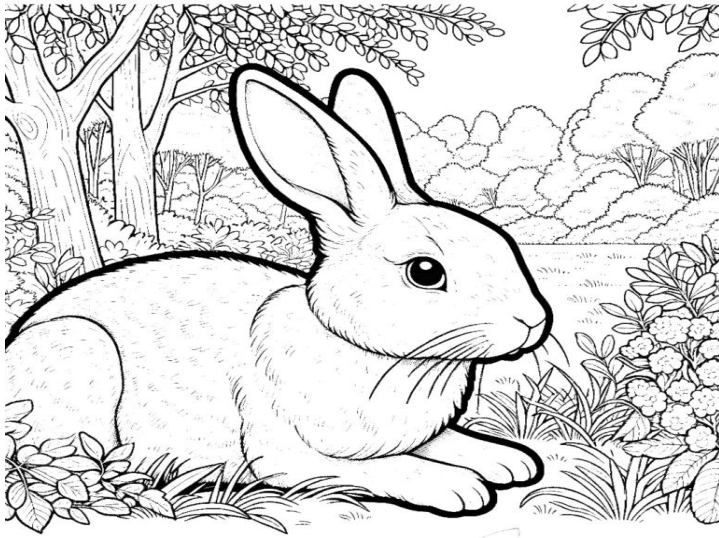
Animal 4. I'm not a bug or a jumper on springs, but a fluffy little creature with the softest of things. What am I?
