

**WAUCONDA PARK DISTRICT
LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS
ORDINANCE NO. 2024-03**

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING AS SURPLUS AND
AUTHORIZING THE SALE OR OTHER CONVEYANCE OR
DISPOSAL OF SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY OF THE
WAUCONDA PARK DISTRICT, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHERE AS, in the opinion of Board of Commissioners of the Wauconda Park District It is no longer necessary or useful to, or in the best interest of, the Park District to retain ownership of the personal property hereinafter described; and

WHERE AS, it is determined by the Board of Commissioners that such personal property is declared surplus, and shall be disposed of in the manner stipulated below; and

WHERE AS, at least three-fifths (3/5) of the Board of Commissioners of the Wauconda Park District finds that the said property is no longer necessary or useful to the Park District's current needs or operations and is thereby considered as surplus property, but that revenue acquired from its sale can be applied to the purchase of similar equipment or other materials needed by the Park District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE WAUCONDA PARK DISTRICT, LAKE COUNTY, STATE OF ILLINOIS as follows;

SECTION 1: That pursuant to authority granted to the Park District under 70ILCS 1205/8-22, the following described personal property now owned by the Wauconda Park District, is no longer necessary and useful to the Park District, and in the best interest of the Park District will be disposed of in the most appropriate manner benefitting the Park District.



SECTION 2: The Board of Commissioners authorizes and directs the Executive Director to take such action necessary to dispose of the Property, as herein authorized by law, in the most appropriate manner benefiting the Park District. Since these items have no resale value, the District anticipates selling them as scrap metal.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from, and after, its adoption as provided by law.

Adopted this 13th day of February 2024, by the affirmative roll call vote of three-fifths of the members of the Board of Commissioners.
