## GENERAL WAIVER & RELEASE

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

The Wauconda Park District is committed to conducting its recreation programs in a safe manner and holds the safety of participants in high regard. The Wauconda Park District continually strives to reduce such risks and insists that all participants follow safety rules and instructions that are designed to protect the participants' safety. However, participants and parents/guardians of minors registering for this program/activity must recognize that there is an inherent risk of injury when choosing to participate in recreational activities.

You are solely responsible for determining if you or your minor child/ward are physically fit and/or skilled for the activities contemplated by this agreement. It is always advisable, especially if the participant is pregnant, disabled in any way or recently suffered an illness, injury or impairment, to consult a physician before undertaking any physical activity.

### WARNING OF RISK

Despite careful and proper preparation, instruction, medical advice, conditioning and equipment, there is still a risk of serious injury when participating in any recreational activity/program. Understandably, not all hazards and dangers can be foreseen. Participants must understand that certain risks, dangers and injuries due to acts of God, inclement weather, slipping, falling, equipment failure, failure in supervision, premises defects and all other circumstances inherent to recreational activities/programs exists. In this regard, it must be recognized that it is impossible for the Wauconda Park District to guarantee absolute safety.

### WAIVER AND RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS AND ASSUMPTIONS OF RISK

Please read this form carefully and be aware that in signing up and participating in this program/activity, you will be expressly assuming the risk and legal liability and waiving and releasing all claims for injuries, damages or loss which you or your minor child/ward might sustain as a result of participating in any and all activities connected with and associated with this program/activity (including transportation services, when provided). I recognize and acknowledge that there are certain risks of physical injury to participants in this program/activity, and I voluntarily agree to assume the full risk Of any and all injuries, damages or loss, regardless of severity, that my minor child/ward or I may sustain as a result of said participation. I further agree to waive and relinquish all claims I or my minor child/ward may have (or accrue to me or my child/ward) as a result of participating in this program/activity against the Wauconda Park District, including its officials, agents, volunteers and employees (hereinafter collectively referred as "Wauconda Park District").

I do hereby fully release and forever discharge the Wauconda Park District from any and all claims for injuries, damages, or loss that my minor child/ward or I May have or which may accrue to me or my minor child/ward and arising out of, connected with, or in any way associated with this program/activity.

## Parking Lots Regulations

1. SOFTBALL Lot is located at 600 N. Main Street (across from Library).
2. FEST Lot is located at 466 N. Main Street (across from High School).
3. You can ONLY park in the lot you have a permit for and in a spot, you are assigned to, or your vehicle will be towed.
4. Your **current** permit must be hung from the mirror for the vehicle it is registered for, **NO EXCEPTIONS** or the vehicle will be ticketed or towed. Please call the Park District office at (847) 526-3610, if you will be using another car temporarily. Please provide your name, vehicle information, and length of time you will be using the other vehicle. If you do not provide the Park District with this information, your car will be ticketed or towed.
5. All vehicles must have a parking placard displayed starting the first day of school, **NO EXCEPTIONS**.  
**STUDENTS MUST PARK IN THEIR DESIGNATED SPOT.**
6. Students who purchase a high school parking sticker/placard to park in the High School lot may not park in the Park District lot. Violators will be ticketed or towed.
7. Vehicle must be parked in a proper manner within the marked lines. Parking is not allowed in handicapped spaces, without a handicapped placard being properly displayed. There is also no parking in spots reserved for District 118 staff, except for marked District 118 Tech Staff. Any vehicle in violation will be ticketed or towed.
8. The Park District is not responsible for any damage or theft that occurs to your vehicle in the lot.
9. Any vehicle leaking fluids will be towed at the owner's expense, after attempting to notify car owner on record at the Park District office.
10. IF YOU REPLACE YOUR VEHICLE, YOU MUST BRING IN NEW CAR INFORMATION. You are responsible for placards.
11. **IF YOU LOSE OR MISPLACE YOUR PLACARD, YOU WILL NOT BE RE-ISSUED ANOTHER ONE. NO REPLACEMENT PLACARDS WILL BE ISSUED. YOU MUST PURCHASE ONE AT FULL PRICE.**
12. Placards are non-transferable from person to person.
13. We may not issue any warnings this year. Cars may be ticketed or removed at owners' expense for any infraction of rules listed.
14. We do not sell all parking spots in our lot to allow us to maneuver park district vehicles to and from our maintenance building.
15. Refunds are not issued unless we have a waiting list, and we can re-sell your parking permit.
