

Public Act 097-0609

Pursuant to Public Act 97-0609, the following information is provided for budget year ending April 30, 2026. \$95,156.25 Base Salary, Vacation Days (19), Sick Days (12), Personal Days (3), 87% Health/Dental/Vision Insurance (\$12,295.44), \$250 per month car allowance, and \$20 per month cell phone reimbursement. Total Compensation Equals = \$110,691.69.28 *

Mike Drinkwine, Director of Parks

\$100,876.98 Base Salary, Vacation Days (20), Sick Days (12), Personal Days (3), 87% Health/Dental/Vision Insurance (\$36,775.68), \$3104.66 use of Company Vehicle, and \$20 per month cell phone reimbursement. Total Compensation = \$140,997.32 **
