At the time that I am writing this message, our recreation staff is busy preparing for our annual Sweetheart Dance and other fun Valentine's Day activities, while our maintenance staff is out plowing the parking lot and shoveling the sidewalks from the brief snowfall we received this morning. As we come out of the cold temperatures and look forward to sunny, warm, spring days and green grass, I ask you to look through this guide and discover all that your Park District has to offer. Our staff has put together a variety of activities for you, your family, and friends to enjoy.

Back in the early 2000's, Park District's, Special Recreation District's, and Forest Preserves adapted the slogan "Take Time For Fun." Like many things from years ago, this slogan has gone away. In our busy day-to-day lives we sometimes forget to take time for ourselves and the things we enjoy. I am challenging you to "Take Time For Fun" in the coming year. Don't wait to apply, as we typically try to have hiring complete by early April.

Bangs Lake Marina - In March, the District will begin redeveloping the old Wauconda Boat Facility. Enhancements include a picnic shelter, overlook with sunning steps, improved boat launch, game tables, stamped concrete board walk, native shoreline plantings, and an ADA kayak and canoe launch. 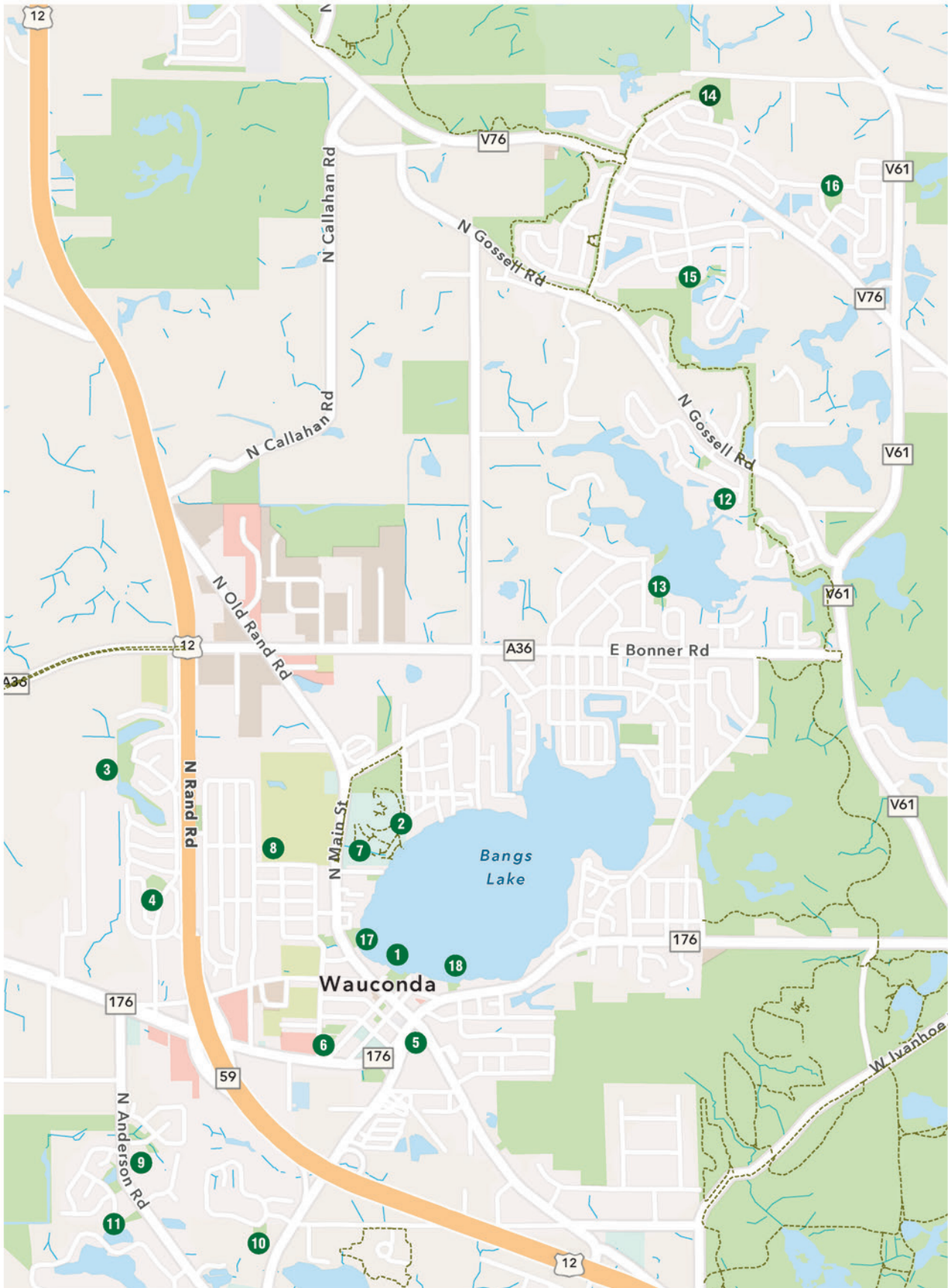

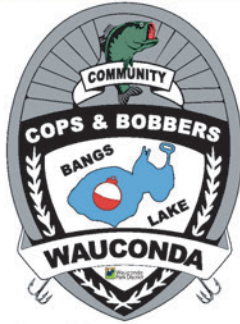

Minnows - Infant and Preschool Aquatic Program (18 mos-3 yrs w/parent)

This class is designed for children who are just starting to learn how to swim. In this parent/child program, children will develop water confidence and essential swimming skills, all while enjoying quality time with their parents or grandparents. Through a curriculum that includes songs, games, and expert guidance from our instructors, children will build a strong foundation for swimming with the support of their parent or guardian, building upon a skill we learned from the previous class. Please note that parents or guardians are required to be in the water with their child during the class.

Guppies - Junior Swim School (3-5 yrs)

This class is to help build confidence in children to enter the water independently and safely. This program is designed with the assumption that children will be entering a body of water for the first time, without the support of a parent, so our instructors approach with ensuring ease and comfortability. This program starts through the development of foundational skills such as putting your face in the water, bobs, kickboard use, and floats before eventually moving on to short lengths of swimming without assistance.

Swim School (5-9 yrs)

Our Swim School program offers a comprehensive approach to developing essential swimming skills that last a lifetime. Each class is designed to introduce a new skill, reinforce previously learned techniques, and conclude with a fun, engaging game to keep kids excited and motivated.

In our group camp swim environment, we focus on building confidence and competence. We start by teaching proper breathing, floatation, and arm positioning, gradually moving toward mastering swim strokes, treading water, and essential lifesaving techniques. Our goal is to inspire and encourage your child at every level, ensuring they develop both proficiency and a love for swimming.

Quick Access Private Swim Lessons
(2 yrs - Adult) (40 minutes)

Parents, after you enroll using the right session code, we will email you to inquire about a preferred date and time that works best.

Private lessons are available based on facility and instructor availability. This option is ideal for those seeking:

- More flexible scheduling to accommodate busy lifestyles.
- A specific instructor they enjoy working with.
- Tailored lessons that focus on individual needs, skills, goals and pace. Discuss any customization requests with coordinator and instructor.

Wauconda High School Student Parking - REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

Student parking permits for Wauconda High School students will go on sale beginning August 3, 2026. To be eligible for purchase of a permit, students and parent/guardians must fill out a registration form, sign off saying they have read the rules & regulations, and turn it in for a lottery pick. Forms are available beginning June 1, 2026 and must be turned into the Community Center Front Office no later than July 30, 2026. Students will be notified if they have been selected to get a parking permit in either our Fest Lot or Softball Lot by August 3, 2026. 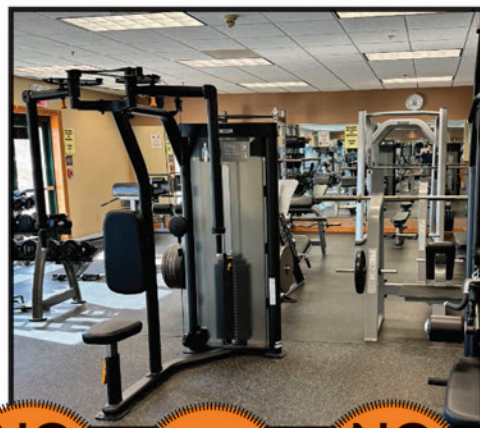

Membership Policies

To qualify for an Individual +1 or a Senior +1 membership, both individuals must reside in the same household. Senior +1 both individuals must be 62 yrs. or older to qualify. Additional family members may not be purchased with the Senior +1 rate.

** Seniors must be a minimum of 62 years old to qualify for any senior rate.

*** Students must be a full-time high school or college student between the ages of 14-25 with at least 12 credit hours. Proof of student status such as a current book bill, class schedule, or dated school ID is required at time of registration.

**** Corporate membership must have a minimum of three employees from the same business enrolled initially to be eligible for the discount. Corporate membership can be prorated and is based upon a one-year membership beginning April 1 and ending March 31, annually.

Fee Policies and Procedures

Monthly payments will be charged one month from the date that a membership begins. It is the member's responsibility to cancel their membership. Cancellation requests must be submitted seven days prior to membership renewal date for a membership to be cancelled. Failure to make this request during this timeframe will result in the member paying an additional monthly fee and membership will be cancelled for the following month.

All Open Gym users will need their hand stamped to be allowed in the gymnasium. This can be done at the Front Desk or Fitness First Desk.

Anyone caught inside the gym that has not paid or has propped open a doorway for purpose of bypassing registration will be removed from the Community Center for a period of time, no less than one month.

Food and drinks are NOT allowed in the gym. If these items are found, staff will throw them away immediately. Bottled water is the only exception.

Basketballs may be checked out from Fitness First. Some form of collateral needs to be given to secure a basketball.

Basketballs must be returned to Fitness First where you will get the collateral returned.

The only persons allowed in the gym are the ones who have paid. Audience members are not permitted.

Only CLEAN gym shoes can be worn in the gym. Boots, especially with black soles, scuff the floor and are not permitted.

Avoid loitering and horseplay.

Speakers or music are not allowed while in the gymnasium.

No swearing, vulgar language, spitting, or tobacco/nicotine products are allowed inside the Community Center.

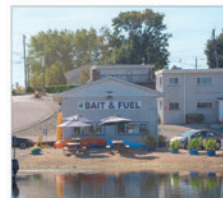

- Refund requests must be submitted a minimum of five days before the start of a class session in order to receive a full refund minus the \$5 service charge. Refund requests made four days or less before a class starts will be refunded at 50% of the class cost less a \$5 service charge.

Waiver

The Wauconda Park District is committed to conducting its recreation programs in a safe manner and holds the safety of participants in high regard. The Wauconda Park District continually strives to reduce such risks and insists that all participants follow safety rules and instructions that are designed to protect the participants' safety. However, participants and parents/guardians of minors registering for this program/activity must recognize that there is an inherent risk of injury when choosing to participate in recreational activities. You are solely responsible for determining if you or your minor child/ward are physically fit and/or skilled for the activities contemplated by this agreement. It is always advisable, especially if the participant is pregnant, disabled in any way or recently suffered an illness, injury, or impairment, to consult a physician before undertaking any physical activity.

Warning of Risk

Despite careful and proper preparation, instruction, medical advice, conditioning and equipment, there is still a risk of serious injury when participating in any recreational activity/program. Understandably, not all hazards and dangers can be foreseen. Participants must understand that certain risks, dangers, and injuries due to acts of god, inclement weather, slipping, falling, equipment failure, failure in supervision, premises defects, and all other circumstances inherent to recreational activities/programs exist. In this regard, it must be recognized that it is impossible for the Wauconda Park District to guarantee absolute safety.

Waiver and Release of all Claims and Assumptions of Risk

Please read this form carefully and be aware that in signing up and participating in this program/activity, you will be expressly assuming the risk and legal liability and waiving and releasing all claims for injuries, damages, or loss which you or your minor child/ward might sustain as a result of participating in any and all activities connected with and associated with this program/activity (including transportation services, when provided.)

I recognize and acknowledge that there are certain risks of physical injury to participants in this program/activity, and I voluntarily agree to assume the full risk of any and all injuries, damages or loss, regardless of severity, that my minor child/ward or I may sustain as a result of said participation. I further agree to waive and relinquish all claims I or my minor child/ward may have (or accrue to me or my child/ward) as a result of participating in this program/activity against the Wauconda Park District, including its officials, agents, volunteers, and employees (hereinafter collectively referred as "Wauconda Park District".)

I do hereby fully release and forever discharge the Wauconda Park District from any and all claims for injuries, damages, or loss that my minor child/ward or I may have or which may accrue to me or my minor child/ward and arising out of, connected with, or in any way associated with this program/activity.

I have read and fully understand the above important information, warning of risk, assumption of risk, and waiver and release of all claims. If registering a minor participant, I further attest that I have read the above to my minor child/ward.



Pet Policy

Pets are welcome in our parks, however for safety reasons, some areas are not acceptable for them. Pets are not allowed during any special event in which there is a high concentration of people in a confined area. Pets are also not allowed on any play field area. These areas include bleachers, or spectator areas, soccer, baseball, softball fields, dugout areas, court areas, or playgrounds. Pet owners are required to keep their pets on a 6' leash at all times, and remove pet droppings. Please kindly understand and respect this policy. Ordinance 2.04.



Photo/Privacy Policy

The Wauconda Park District uses photographs of participants in programs and special events to inform others about the recreational opportunities available in our community. We do not use identification in our brochure without prior consent. If you do not wish to have your picture taken, please inform the photographer. All personal information given to us through registration will be kept confidential. At no time will the WPD give, sell, or release personal information without your prior consent.



Notice to Parents- Drop Off and Pick Up

Attention parents—it is your responsibility to walk your minor child to and from class. Dropping kids off in front of our building is considered a safety issue. If a child is left unattended after a class or activity for a long period of time, we will call the police.



Class Schedules

All classes listed in the brochure have dates that detail when the class will meet. If a class is missed during the scheduled session for instructor illness or other conflict, a "make-up" class will be added to the end of the session or a class will be extended. A note or a call from the park district, or a class announcement will communicate that change to you. We are only closed for major holidays. Again, please refer to the class schedule or call as we do NOT follow the school's schedule for all classes.



Residency

To qualify as a resident, you must reside within the village. Households located in unincorporated Wauconda are considered NON-RESIDENT. If you are unsure, you can check your property tax bill to see what park district you pay taxes to. PROOF OF RESIDENCY MAY BE REQUIRED.



ADA/NISRA

The Wauconda Park District complies with the Americans for Disabilities Act. Persons with special needs are encouraged to contact the Park District regarding accommodations to our programs. You may also contact NISRA at (815) 459-0737, who can assist you with the programs and services they offer. Wauconda Park District is a proud member of NISRA, who offers a full-line of community programs from infants to seniors-and Special Olympics.



Safety/Waiver/Insurance

The Wauconda Park District is currently a member of PDRMA—a risk management pool made up of 154+ area park districts. Through their directives and guidance we are constantly striving to make your park district the safest it can be. For liability purposes the Wauconda Park District requires an adult to sign a waiver before participation can begin. The Wauconda Park District provides NO insurance for any injury or damage that may occur. We strongly recommend that you check with your insurance carrier.



Behavior Policy

To ensure safe and enjoyable programs, activities, and facilities for all residents, the Wauconda Park District has developed the following Code of Conduct. Participants are expected to exhibit appropriate behavior at all times when involved in Park District programs, activities, events, leagues, and while using the Park District Facilities and Parks.

1. Show respect to all participants and staff.
2. Refrain from using foul or obscene language.
3. Refrain from causing bodily harm to participants and staff.
4. Refrain from communicating threats, inappropriate comments, or actions that can be considered as any type of harassment, direct threat or actions that pose a threat by gesture, words, or actions.
5. Exhibit tolerance and courtesies and commonly accepted behavior towards our diverse community.
6. Show respect to equipment, supplies, and facilities.
7. Exhibit good sportsmanship at athletic events whether an active participant or observer.
8. The use, suspected use, or consumption of alcohol or illegal substances on Park District property is prohibited. While alcohol is approved for select special and off property events, it is expected that all residents and participants will exhibit good judgment and moderation when alcohol is consumed.

The Wauconda Park District reserves the right to dismiss without refund any participant who violates the behavior policy. In addition, if it is felt that such actions pose a threat to the general safety or welfare of other participants, an individual or group may risk consequences associated with the summoning of the Wauconda Police.

Residents with Disabilities
