As we are moving into the new year, I wanted to take this opportunity to recognize the Wauconda Park District staff for always striving to ensure that our programs and services are in line with this statement and thank them for their ongoing dedication to our mission. I look forward to seeing all the innovative and creative programming that is in our future.

Employee Recognition – Quarterly the District recognizes employees for their years of service to the community. On December 9, our Board will be recognizing two employees:

Alan Emmerich, Parkman - 20 years

Kelly Ftacek, Preschool Coordinator – 15 years

Osage Park – This park has been heavily used since it's official grand reopening on September 6, 2025. Final touch-ups to the park were completed throughout the month of September. Upgrades to the park included a new playground, two pickleball courts, a new futsal court, and renovations to the basketball and tennis courts. We look forward to planning more programs at this park next Spring including small tournaments, lessons, and drop-in competitive play.

Bangs Lake Marina – The District has been working diligently to complete the final design for the new Bangs Lake Marina. A rendering of the proposed design is shown at the bottom of this page. This project will be partially funded through a matching OSLAD (Open Space Land Acquisition and Development) grant administered by the Illinois Department of Natural Resources. The current design calls for an ADA kayak/canoe launch, refurbished launch ramp, table games, picnic shelter, overlook with sunning steps, parking lot resurfacing, boardwalk, and native shoreline plantings. Demolition of the current structures located on the property is expected to begin in late winter/early Spring.

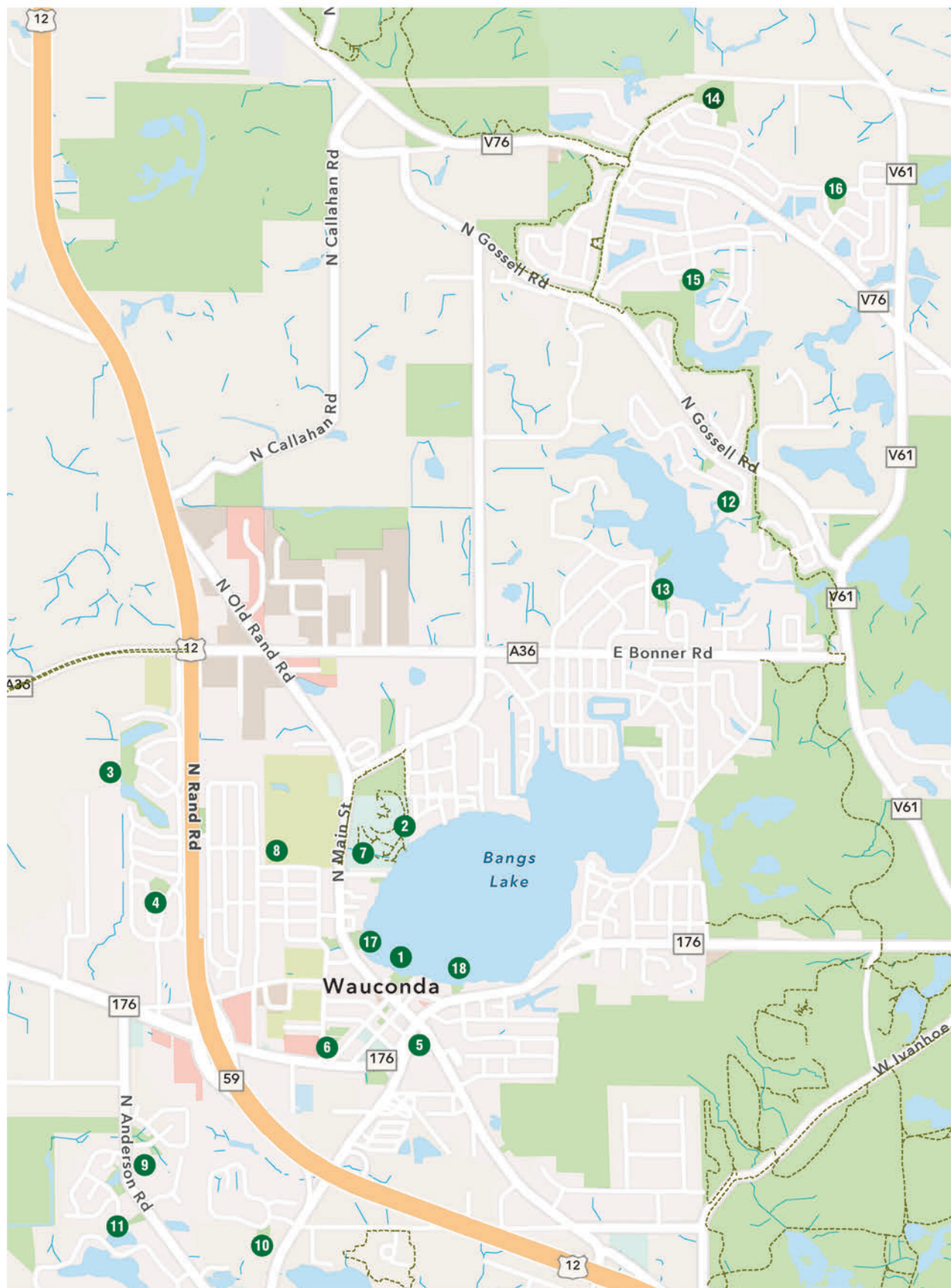

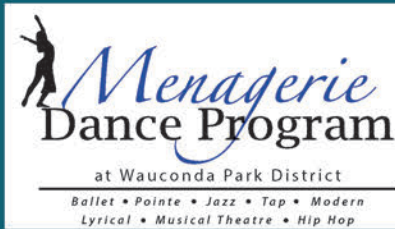

Intro to Creative Dance (2.5-3 yrs)

Our youngest ballet class introduces students to the magical world of ballet. We use a variety of props to stimulate the students' imaginations and spark their creativity when dancing. The main goals at this level are learning to listen to the teacher, following directions, cooperating and sharing with other dancers. **This is a drop off class.**

Creative Dance (3-4 yrs)

Creative Dance blends movement, music, improvisation, and basic dance steps while providing an excellent introduction for the future study of all dance techniques. Students learn dance fundamentals while improving motor skills, self-expression, confidence, imagination and social development. Dancer must be fully potty trained, no pull-ups. **This is a drop off class.**

Pre-Ballet and Tap (4-6 yrs)

The basics of ballet and tap techniques are combined with props and imagination to give children a fun and educational class. This class will work on large motor skills, balance, coordination, spatial awareness, musicality and self-expression. **This is a drop off class.**

Pre-Jazz and Hip Hop (4-6 yrs)

The basics of jazz and hip hop techniques are combined with props and imagination to give children a fun and educational class. This class will work on large motor skills, balance, coordination, spatial awareness, musicality and self-expression. **This is a drop off class.**

Lyrical (7-10 yrs)

Lyrical is a fusion of ballet and jazz dance techniques. Lyrical dance challenges dancers to use movement to interpret music and express emotion telling a story through every movement made.

Menagerie Preparatory Company (6-8 yrs)

Menagerie Preparatory Company is an extension of Menagerie Dance Company. This is a non-auditioned, preparatory level of company for dancers interested in auditioning for Menagerie Dance Company when they are of age. This group will perform in our annual Spring Recital in May and join our Menagerie Dance Company performing at Wauconda Fest in June. Tuition includes weekly rehearsals, costume, digital download of recital performance, and company t-shirt.

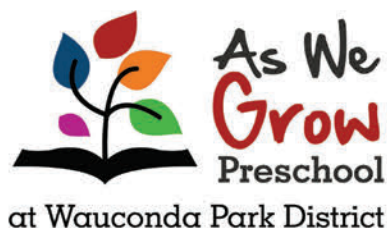

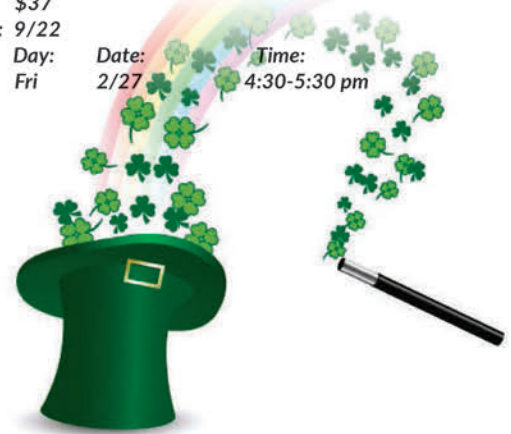

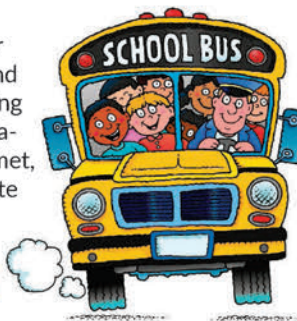

One of the most important services Wauconda CERT offers is a free Emergency Preparedness training class. This class is open to the public and those interested in joining CERT. After completion of the course, individuals become eligible to join CERT and begin assisting our emergency response efforts. However, there is no obligation to participate in CERT.

This is a device present in many work environments that analyzes heart rhythms and determines if a shock is needed to re-establish an effective rhythm. 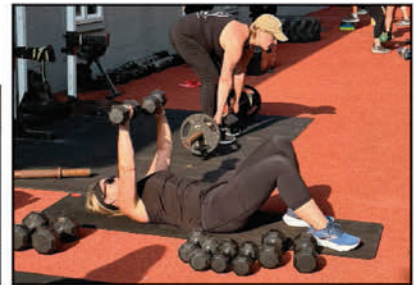

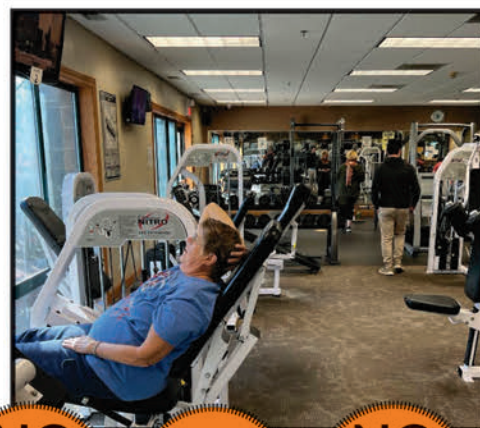

Membership Policies

To qualify for an Individual +1 or a Senior +1 membership, both individuals must reside in the same household. Senior +1 both individuals must be 62 yrs. or older to qualify. Additional family members may not be purchased with the Senior +1 rate.

** Seniors must be a minimum of 62 years old to qualify for any senior rate.

*** Students must be a full-time high school or college student between the ages of 14-25 with at least 12 credit hours. Proof of student status such as a current book bill, class schedule, or dated school ID is required at time of registration.

****Corporate membership must have a minimum of three employees from the same business enrolled initially to be eligible for the discount. Corporate membership can be prorated and is based upon a one-year membership beginning April 1 and ending March 31, annually.

Fee Policies and Procedures

Monthly payments will be charged one month from the date that a membership begins. It is the member's responsibility to cancel their membership. Cancellation requests must be submitted seven days prior to membership renewal date for a membership to be cancelled. Failure to make this request during this timeframe will result in the member paying an additional monthly fee and membership will be cancelled for the following month.

There will be a \$35 charge for insufficient funds from a checking account or \$10 charge for transactions returned unpaid for problems with the account on file.

Fees subject to change. It is the members responsibility to keep payment information current.

Memberships are non-refundable and non-transferable. (Rates are subject to change).

High School age students between 14-17 years old need a parent present when signing up for a fitness/open gym pass or renewing a membership. No exceptions.

OPEN GYM

Open Gym Membership includes: Pickleball Open Gym and Regular Open Gym

You must have a current Open Gym Membership OR you can pay for a day pass but must have a membership application on file with parent signature (if under 18 years of age). NO EXCEPTIONS!

NEW MEMBERSHIP FEES: See page 34. *Wauconda High School Students are charged Resident rate.

All Open Gym users will need their hand stamped to be allowed in the gymnasium. This can be done at the Front Desk or Fitness First Desk.

Anyone caught inside the gym that has not paid or has propped open a doorway for purpose of bypassing registration will be removed from the Community Center for a period of time, no less than one month.

Food and drinks are NOT allowed in the gym. If these items are found, staff will throw them away immediately. Bottled water is the only exception.

Basketballs may be checked out from Fitness First. Some form of collateral needs to be given to secure a basketball.

Basketballs must be returned to Fitness First where you will get the collateral returned.

The only persons allowed in the gym are the ones who have paid. Audience members are not permitted.

Only CLEAN gym shoes can be worn in the gym. Boots, especially with black soles, scuff the floor and are not permitted.

Avoid loitering and horseplay.

Speakers or music are not allowed while in the gymnasium.

No swearing, vulgar language, spitting, or tobacco/nicotine products are allowed inside the Community Center.

There is a zero tolerance policy on fighting, pushing, shoving, or gang action on Park property; if there is a problem, law enforcement will be notified immediately.

Dunking or hanging on the rims is strictly forbidden. Those doing this will be asked to leave premises immediately.

Fitness towels are for Fitness First members only.

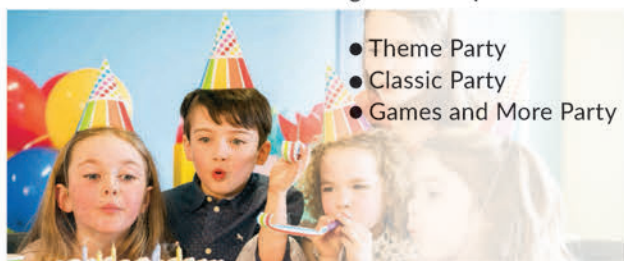

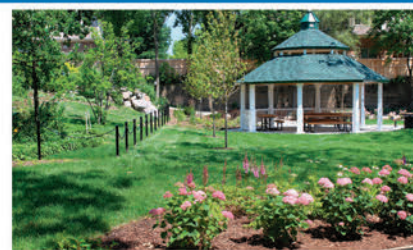

After hours, you can leave registration forms or payment in our night time drop box, located in the Community Center circle.



2- By Mail

Pick up or download our registration form, fill out completely, sign waiver on the back, include payment, and mail to us-600 N Main Street, Wauconda, IL 60084. If we receive your registration before the registration dates that apply to you, we will hold until the proper time. If a class is full, we will call you with options.



3- By Fax

Pick up or download our registration form, fill out completely, including the waiver on the back. Be sure to include all program information and a credit/debit card number with an expiration date. Fax both sides of the form to (847) 526-3791 anytime of day. If a class is full or we do not have all the information that is necessary, we will call you.



4- Online

Visit our website at www.waucondaparks.com and go to the registration page. You can register for programs using our secure server and a credit card. Be sure to see all the other great Park District information and updates that are available to you on this site. You can e-mail us with any questions by clicking the contact us tab on our website, and we will return your inquiry.

Satisfaction Guarantee/Refunds

The Wauconda Park District is constantly striving to offer you the best in recreation activities, events, and programs. If you are not completely satisfied, please tell us and we will arrange one of the following:

- You may transfer to another class if space is available or have the fee left as a class credit for future use.
- A pro-rated refund will be provided if requested prior to the third class meeting.
- Upon proof, a pro-rated refund will be given for medical reasons or moving out of town.
- All refunds are subject to a \$5 service charge. This fee is waived if the refund is left as a household credit.
- Refunds are not given for facility passes, leagues, trips, special events, CLUB, preschool, or summer day camp.
- Refunds can take up to three weeks to process and are mailed by check, credit back to your credit card, or class credit.
- A pro-rated class credit will be processed for contractual class requests up to the third meeting.
- Participants registered for classes that are cancelled due to low enrollment will be issued a class credit for future use. Participants must request a refund if they would like their class credit refunded.
- Refund requests must be submitted a minimum of five days before the start of a class session in order to receive a full refund minus the \$5 service charge. Refund requests made four days or less before a class starts will be refunded at 50% of the class cost less a \$5 service charge.

Waiver

The Wauconda Park District is committed to conducting its recreation programs in a safe manner and holds the safety of participants in high regard. The Wauconda Park District continually strives to reduce such risks and insists that all participants follow safety rules and instructions that are designed to protect the participants' safety. However, participants and parents/guardians of minors registering for this program/activity must recognize that there is an inherent risk of injury when choosing to participate in recreational activities. You are solely responsible for determining if you or your minor child/ward are physically fit and/or skilled for the activities contemplated by this agreement. It is always advisable, especially if the participant is pregnant, disabled in any way or recently suffered an illness, injury, or impairment, to consult a physician before undertaking any physical activity.

Warning of Risk

Despite careful and proper preparation, instruction, medical advice, conditioning and equipment, there is still a risk of serious injury when participating in any recreational activity/program. Understandably, not all hazards and dangers can be foreseen. Participants must understand that certain risks, dangers, and injuries due to acts of god, inclement weather, slipping, falling, equipment failure, failure in supervision, premises defects, and all other circumstances inherent to recreational activities/programs exist. In this regard, it must be recognized that it is impossible for the Wauconda Park District to guarantee absolute safety.

Waiver and Release of all Claims and Assumptions of Risk

Please read this form carefully and be aware that in signing up and participating in this program/activity, you will be expressly assuming the risk and legal liability and waiving and releasing all claims for injuries, damages, or loss which you or your minor child/ward might sustain as a result of participating in any and all activities connected with and associated with this program/activity (including transportation services, when provided.)

I recognize and acknowledge that there are certain risks of physical injury to participants in this program/activity, and I voluntarily agree to assume the full risk of any and all injuries, damages or loss, regardless of severity, that my minor child/ward or I may sustain as a result of said participation. I further agree to waive and relinquish all claims I or my minor child/ward may have (or accrue to me or my child/ward) as a result of participating in this program/activity against the Wauconda Park District, including its officials, agents, volunteers, and employees (hereinafter collectively referred as "Wauconda Park District").

I do hereby fully release and forever discharge the Wauconda Park District from any and all claims for injuries, damages, or loss that my minor child/ward or I may have or which may accrue to me or my minor child/ward and arising out of, connected with, or in any way associated with this program/activity.

I have read and fully understand the above important information, warning of risk, assumption of risk, and waiver and release of all claims. If registering a minor participant, I further attest that I have read the above to my minor child/ward.



Pet Policy

Pets are welcome in our parks, however for safety reasons, some areas are not acceptable for them. Pets are not allowed during any special event in which there is a high concentration of people in a confined area. Pets are also not allowed on any play field area. These areas include bleachers, or spectator areas, soccer, baseball, softball fields, dugout areas, court areas, or playgrounds. Pet owners are required to keep their pets on a 6' leash at all times, and remove pet droppings. Please kindly understand and respect this policy. Ordinance 2.04.



Photo/Privacy Policy

The Wauconda Park District uses photographs of participants in programs and special events to inform others about the recreational opportunities available in our community. We do not use identification in our brochure without prior consent. If you do not wish to have your picture taken, please inform the photographer. All personal information given to us through registration will be kept confidential. At no time will the WPD give, sell, or release personal information without your prior consent.



Notice to Parents- Drop Off and Pick Up

Attention parents—it is your responsibility to walk your minor child to and from class. Dropping kids off in front of our building is considered a safety issue. If a child is left unattended after a class or activity for a long period of time, we will call the police.



Class Schedules

All classes listed in the brochure have dates that detail when the class will meet. If a class is missed during the scheduled session for instructor illness or other conflict, a "make-up" class will be added to the end of the session or a class will be extended. A note or a call from the park district, or a class announcement will communicate that change to you. We are only closed for major holidays. Again, please refer to the class schedule or call as we do NOT follow the school's schedule for all classes.



Residency

To qualify as a resident, you must reside within the village. Households located in unincorporated Wauconda are considered NON-RESIDENT. If you are unsure, you can check your property tax bill to see what park district you pay taxes to. PROOF OF RESIDENCY MAY BE REQUIRED.



ADA/NISRA

The Wauconda Park District complies with the Americans for Disabilities Act. Persons with special needs are encouraged to contact the Park District regarding accommodations to our programs. You may also contact NISRA at (815) 459-0737, who can assist you with the programs and services they offer. Wauconda Park District is a proud member of NISRA, who offers a full-line of community programs from infants to seniors and Special Olympics.



Safety/Waiver/Insurance

The Wauconda Park District is currently a member of PDRMA—a risk management pool made up of 154+ area park districts. Through their directives and guidance we are constantly striving to make your park district the safest it can be. For liability purposes the Wauconda Park District requires an adult to sign a waiver before participation can begin. The Wauconda Park District provides NO insurance for any injury or damage that may occur. We strongly recommend that you check with your insurance carrier.



Behavior Policy

To ensure safe and enjoyable programs, activities, and facilities for all residents, the Wauconda Park District has developed the following Code of Conduct. Participants are expected to exhibit appropriate behavior at all times when involved in Park District programs, activities, events, leagues, and while using the Park District Facilities and Parks.

1. Show respect to all participants and staff.
2. Refrain from using foul or obscene language.
3. Refrain from causing bodily harm to participants and staff.
4. Refrain from communicating threats, inappropriate comments, or actions that can be considered as any type of harassment, direct threat or actions that pose a threat by gesture, words, or actions.
5. Exhibit tolerance and courtesies and commonly accepted behavior towards our diverse community.
6. Show respect to equipment, supplies, and facilities.
7. Exhibit good sportsmanship at athletic events whether an active participant or observer.
8. The use, suspected use, or consumption of alcohol or illegal substances on Park District property is prohibited. While alcohol is approved for select special and off property events, it is expected that all residents and participants will exhibit good judgment and moderation when alcohol is consumed.

The Wauconda Park District reserves the right to dismiss without refund any participant who violates the behavior policy. In addition, if it is felt that such actions pose a threat to the general safety or welfare of other participants, an individual or group may risk consequences associated with the summoning of the Wauconda Police.

Residents with Disabilities

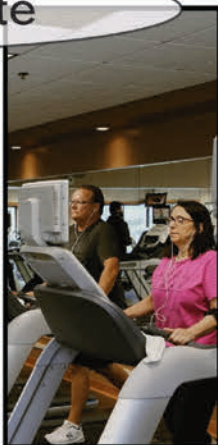
