Camp Wauconda offers a full-time and part-time format with age-appropriate activities like arts and crafts, swimming, games, field trips, theme days, special events, and much more! Camp Wauconda is for children entering grades K-8 in Fall of 2024.

### Camp Format:

Camp Wauconda is an active day camp that is planned by our Camp Coordinator, Camp Counselors, Recreation Staff, and campers themselves. Our staff to camper ratio is 1:10 for grades K-5 and 1:15 for grades 6-8. Kids are grouped by grade, so they are interacting with kids their own age. Each week a new theme is incorporated into the planned activities, projects, and games. We plan off-site field trips, swimming at Phil's Beach, and special events each week! You may pick and choose the weeks you'd like or sign up for a full summer of fun!!

### Registration Information:

No registration fee! You are required to make a non-refundable \$20 deposit for each week your child will attend. \$20 deposit will go towards the fee for that week. Dates may change due to District #118 schedule. Siblings receive a 10% discount on the lesser amount (if applicable) when registering for the same week(s) of camp. More than one change to camp registration will incur a \$10 service fee. Each camper will receive one T-shirt for the entire summer. Additional camp shirt available for \$15 at Community Center front desk.

### Field Trips:

School Age Camp (K-5) will have field trips each Wednesday. Teen Camp (grades 6-8) will go on field trips each Tuesday and Thursday. Field trips are included in the weekly cost of camp. Some field trips may require an additional fee or waiver to be signed by a parent/guardian.
